Private Equity Research: Tools of the Trade

Upon completion of the course, participants will be able to answer the following questions:

- What is Private Equity?
- What are the main sources of PE data available (print & electronic)?
- What are some of the key terms of the industry?

Private equity (PE) and Venture Capital (VC) play a fundamental role in providing capital to companies throughout their various stages of development. Finding information on PE and VC firms along with their investments is quite difficult given the lack of public disclosure requirements. This course will explore the inner workings and key terms of the industry along with an examination of the various data sources used to gather information on this sector on a global basis.

About the Speaker: Clifford Perry

Clifford has extensive knowledge and experience in information systems and services and has spent most of his career in financial services. As a Director at Warburg Pincus he has expanded the information center into a global operation. He has taught numerous classes including Internet Searching with Google, Using ThomsonOne Analytics and Bloomberg.
