Placement Committee Goals and Objectives

The LLAM Placement service is available to all individuals. The purpose of the committee is to provide information to potential employers and job seekers. We work to bring employers and job seekers together by maintaining a visible presence in the field.

Job Searching Tips

Tip #1: Network. Get involved in law library organizations.

Tip #2: Keep your skills sharp. Consider taking a Continuing Education course related to law librarianship, online searching, web/intranet design. Online vendors such as Westlaw, Lexis and others offer refresher courses. LLAM also provides educational programs throughout the year.

What you should know

Many jobs are posted each year for law librarians. Jobs in academic law libraries are oftentimes advertised nationally. Jobs in court and county law libraries and firms may only be advertised locally. AALL has a placement committee that coordinates personal interviews each year, in July, at the AALL Annual Meeting.

Where to look

The job database on the AALL webpage is updated regularly and includes jobs in all kinds of libraries. In addition, many jobs are posted on chapter listservs and websites. LLSDC, SLA, ALA and MLA maintain a jobline on their websites.

The Baltimore Sun and Washington Post contain ads for law librarians in the Sunday employment sections. Both can be searched on their websites.

The LLAM listserv is here to assist you and there are a few placement agencies that will work with law librarians. They specialize in temporary, temp to hire, and direct hire opportunities.
