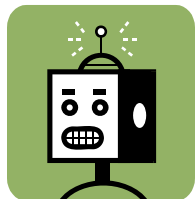

Location: Connors Family Conference & Retreat Center
20 Glen Street
Dover, MA 02030

Accommodations: The Connors Family Conference & Retreat Center has accommodations available for the night of Thursday, November 2. The dormitory-style accommodations consist of single rooms and shared baths. Linens will be supplied. The cost of accommodations is **in addition** to the conference registration fee.

Directions:

From I-93 or Route 128: Take exit 16B Route 109 towards Westwood, merge onto Route 109 and take a right onto Country Club Road/Grove Street. Continue straight past the Dedham Country & Polo Country Club until you come to a stop sign, where you take a left onto Dedham Street and continue until you come to a stop sign in Dover Center. Take a left at the stop sign and immediately bear right before the statue of the eagle – go past the Dover Library and merge onto Springdale Avenue. Continue straight to the end and take a left onto Farm Street. Continue straight for 1.3 miles and take a right onto Wight Lane. At the end of Wight Lane, take a right onto Glen Street and the entrance to the retreat center is 500 yards on the left.

From Boston College: Start out going west on Route 30 (Commonwealth Avenue) toward College Road/Mt. Alvernia Road (1.1 miles). Turn left onto Centre Street (1.3 miles). Turn right onto Boylston Street (0.8 miles). Stay straight to go onto Boylston Street/Route 9. Continue to follow Route 9 West (2.4 miles). Take the Route 16 ramp (0.1 miles). Turn slight left onto Washington Street/Route 16 (1.6 miles). Turn left onto Washington Street/Route 16 (make sure not to go into Wellesley Center). Continue to follow Route 16 (2.0 miles). Turn left onto Pleasant Street S (0.2 miles). Turn right onto Glen Street (2.1 miles). End at 20 Glen Street, Dover, MA.
