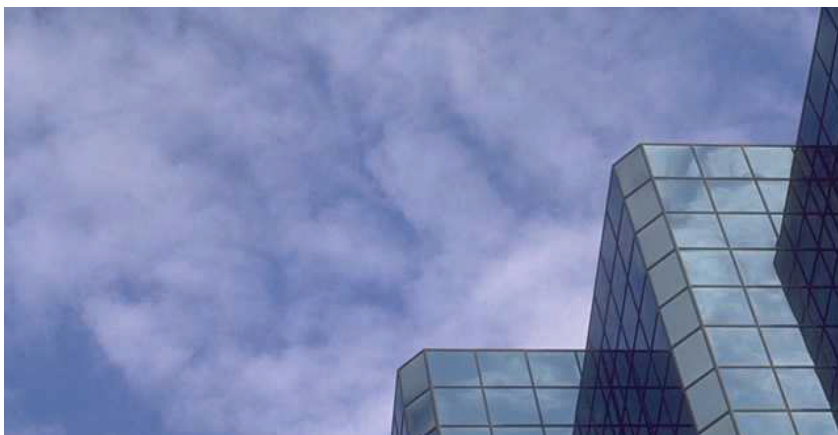

 - West contributing \$500.
 - SNELLA contributing proportionally less than LLNE
- Old Business
 - Roseanne Shea – Chair of Publicity Committee
