

Oral Histories of Oklahoma Judges and Attorneys

The oral history interviewing project will produce a dynamic collection of interviews. The goal of the project is to interview thirty-five (35) attorneys and/or judges throughout the state of Oklahoma to gain insight into their experiences, Oklahoma courts, and unique aspects of the Oklahoma judicial system. To that end, the project coordinator has interviewed narrators, processed some of those interviews, and forwarded completed interviews to the Technical Services Department. Once the interviews are complete, the project coordinator would like to make portions of the audio or transcripts available electronically via a Web site. Also, the full interviews will be available for checkout at the Oklahoma City University Law Library or via interlibrary loan. The final report will detail how the project coordinator chose narrators, developed questions, processed interviews, and made those interviews available electronically.
