### **Report of the Education Committee, 2010 – 2011**

The Education Committee met during the 2010 Annual Meeting (July 12<sup>th</sup> at 12 pm) to discuss program proposals for the 2011 Annual Meeting. Members brainstormed several ideas and solicited the SIS for additional suggestions. The Committee requested that proposers seeking SCCLL-SIS sponsorship submit proposals to the Committee for review first before formal submission to the Annual Meeting Program Committee (AMPC).

This year, the Committee sponsored (or co-sponsored) eight programs and one workshop that were proposed to the AMPC. Of these, the AMPC selected the following four programs:

- D-5: The Role of the Law Library in Serving the Illiterate in their Quest for Access to Justice
- F-3: Friending the Courts: Grappling with Social Networking in Litigation and the Justice System (co-sponsored with CS-SIS)
- J-6: The Struggle for Information Access and Instruction in Less Populous Areas (co-sponsored with ALL-SIS)
- K-5: Innovations in Services to Self Represented (co-sponsored with LISP-SIS)
