2007-08 Report

The committee which consists of the entire SCCLL Executive Board had an active year and took actions with the 2006-2011 Strategic Directions as a guide. They first reviewed and revised all Committee charges with the help of each Committee chair. These charges are updated on the SCCLL website. They also looked at ways in which Self-Represented Litigants impact law libraries and how we as a section could connect with other like minded people. Part of this connection was the establishment of an AALL Representative for the Self-Represented Litigation Network. Charley Dyer was named the first Representative on a one year basis. Through this group, many SCCLL librarians attended the Equal Justice Conference in May to present programs and speak with those in the legal aid community.

The committee began the creation of a SCCLL Officer Handbook which would include the Strategic Directions and basic duties and timelines for each officer. This handbook would be modeled after other Chapters or SIS handbooks which discuss the responsibilities for each officer in the organization. A draft of this document will be available for discussion at the annual meeting in Portland.

Thanks to each member of the committee for their time and commitment to improving our SIS in many ways.
