The committee which consists of the entire SCCLL Executive Board had a quiet year but continued to carry out the 2006-2011 Strategic Directons. The connection with the Self-Represented Litigation Network was furthered as Marcus Hochstetler became the AALL Representative to this organization. Several members also attended the Equal Justice Conference in May with special travel grants from SCCLL Silent Auction Funds. At the EJC, discussions were held to involve Law Librarians of all types in the training of Public Librarians on basic legal research.

The committee continued to support the advocacy efforts of county law libraries in Ohio, New Jersey and Connecticut in their effort to mitigate damage to their funding. The committee worked on a SCCLL Officer Handbook which would include the basic duties and timelines for each officer. This handbook will be modeled after other Chapters or SIS handbooks which discuss the responsibilities for each officer in the organization.
