CARA LEGAL RESEARCH SOFTWARE WINS 2017 AALL NEW PRODUCT AWARD

*American Association of Law Libraries Recognizes Casetext's
Automated Research Assistant*

CHICAGO, May 9, 2017—The American Association of Law Libraries (AALL) has chosen Casetext's automated legal research assistant CARA as its 2017 New Product Award winner.

CARA—which stands for Case Analysis Research Assistant—automates legal research through artificial intelligence (AI) and machine learning using a “brief-as-query” platform that returns a list of suggested cases in seconds that are highly relevant to, but not cited in, the document.

The results are powered by Casetext's database of more than 10 million cases, statutes, and regulations, which is updated daily and includes all published and unpublished federal cases dating back to 1925 and appellate cases from all 50 states. The platform also features hundreds of thousands of articles written by practicing attorneys.

AALL's New Product Award honors new commercial information products that enhance or improve existing law library services or procedures—or products that improve access to legal information, the legal research process, or procedures for the technical processing of library materials.

Eligible new products may include computer hardware and/or software; educational or bibliographic material; or other products and devices that aid or improve library workflow, research, or intellectual access. New products are considered to be those in the library-related marketplace for two years or less. Products that have been reintroduced in a new format or with substantial changes are also eligible.

“AALL is pleased to announce that Casetext is the recipient of this year's New Product Award for its CARA software,” AALL President Ronald E. Wheeler Jr. said. “AALL members are at the forefront in adopting and maximizing the benefits of artificial intelligence-based technology that



supplements traditional legal research. CARA's 'brief-as-query' AI platform empowers legal information professionals and their employers with efficient, comprehensive results."

"We are thrilled and humbled to have been awarded AALL's New Product of the year," said Pablo Arredondo, Casetext vice president of legal research. "The early and enthusiastic adoption of CARA by lawyers and courts across the country has deepened our conviction that the future of legal research is powerful, context-aware technology that leverages artificial intelligence. We look forward to continuing to improve CARA based on the feedback from our users and the innovations of our team."
