The Vice-Chair/Chair Elect for 2014-2015 served as a member of the OBS-SIS Education Committee for the 2015 Annual Meeting. The Annual Meeting Program Committee (AMPC) instituted a new approach for program planning to ensure that the American Association of Law Libraries (AALL) continues to design and deliver educational programming needed by its membership to problem-solve workplace challenges and raise the profile of the law library profession.
