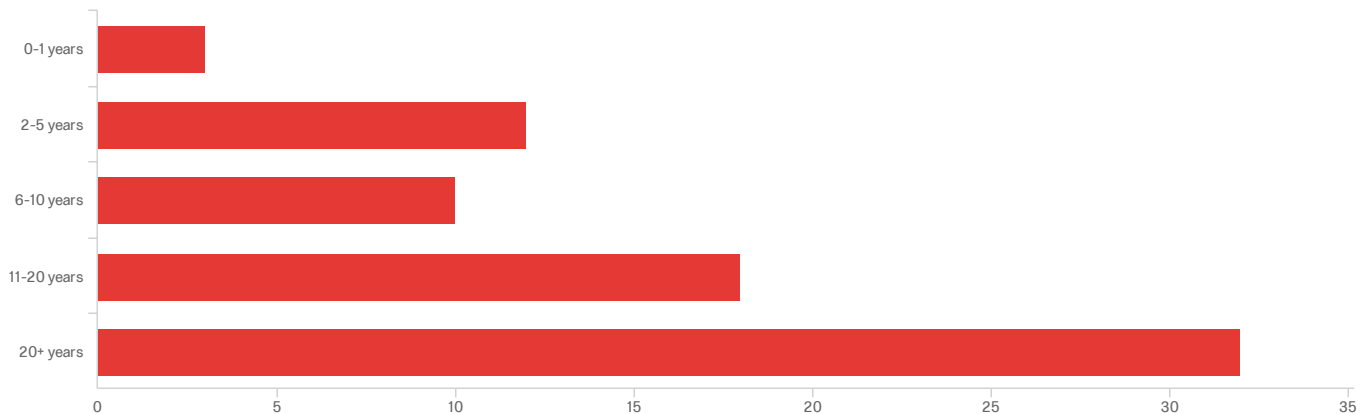

Q1 - How long have you worked in a law library?

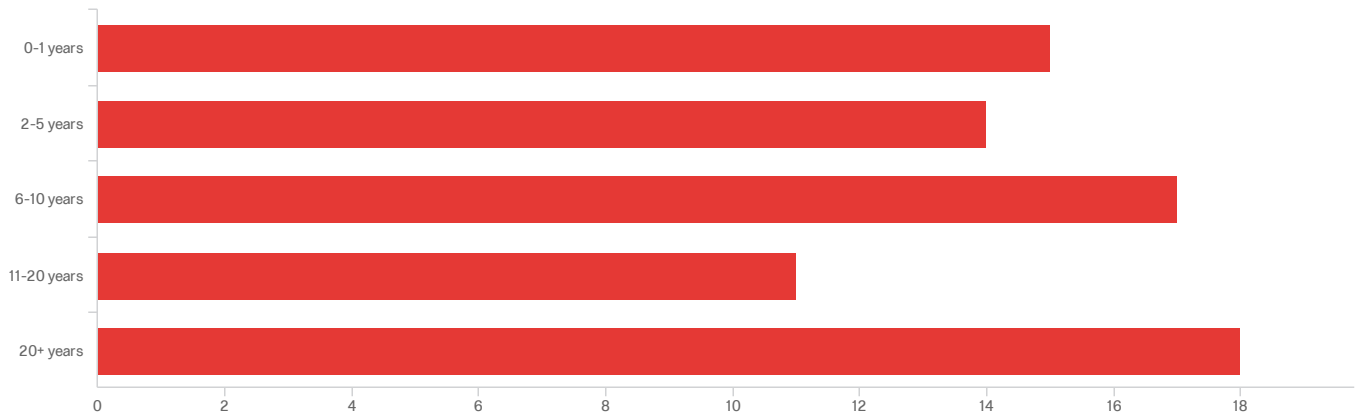

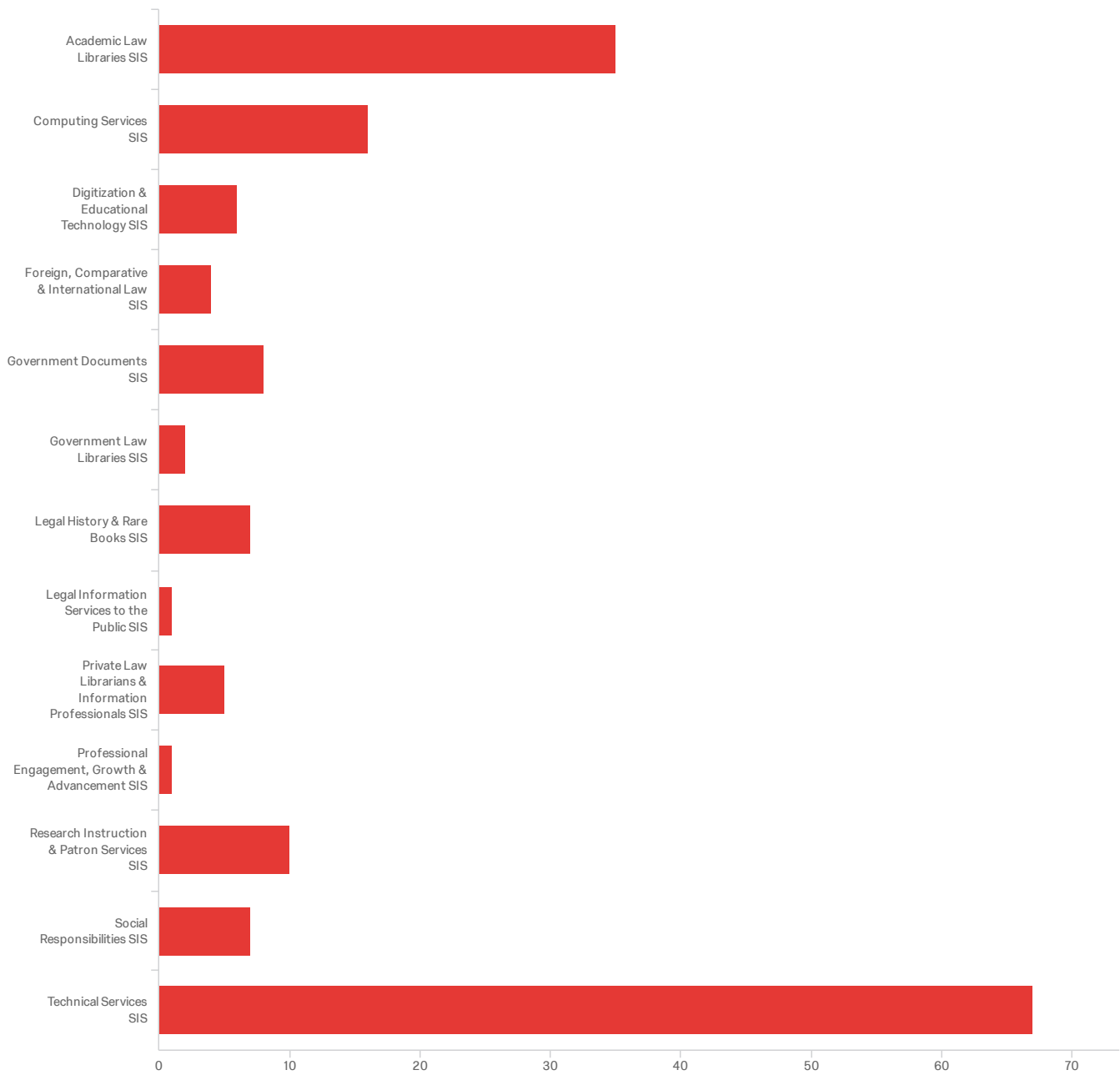

Q10 - Do you plan to attend the 2019 AALL Annual Meeting in D.C.?



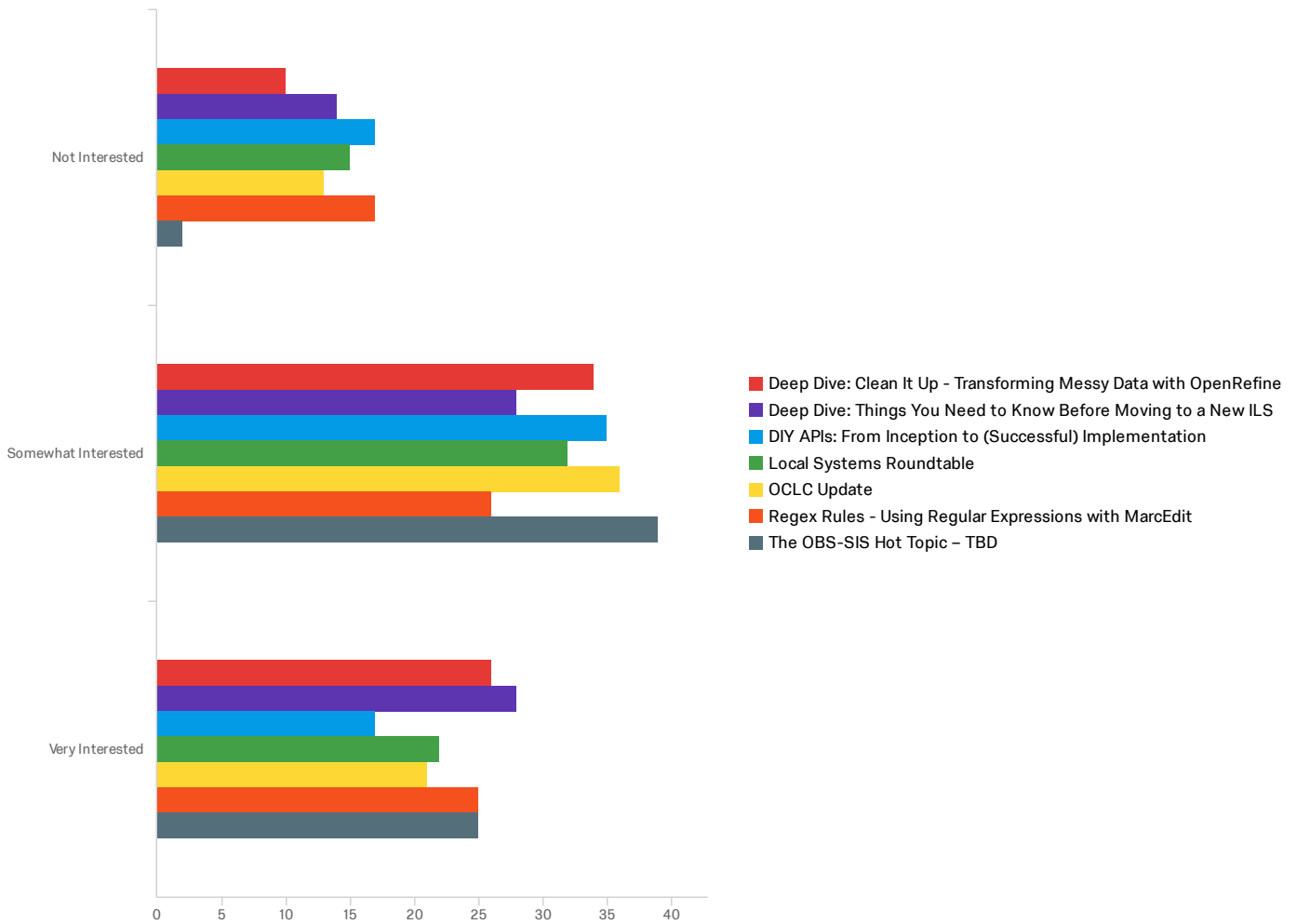

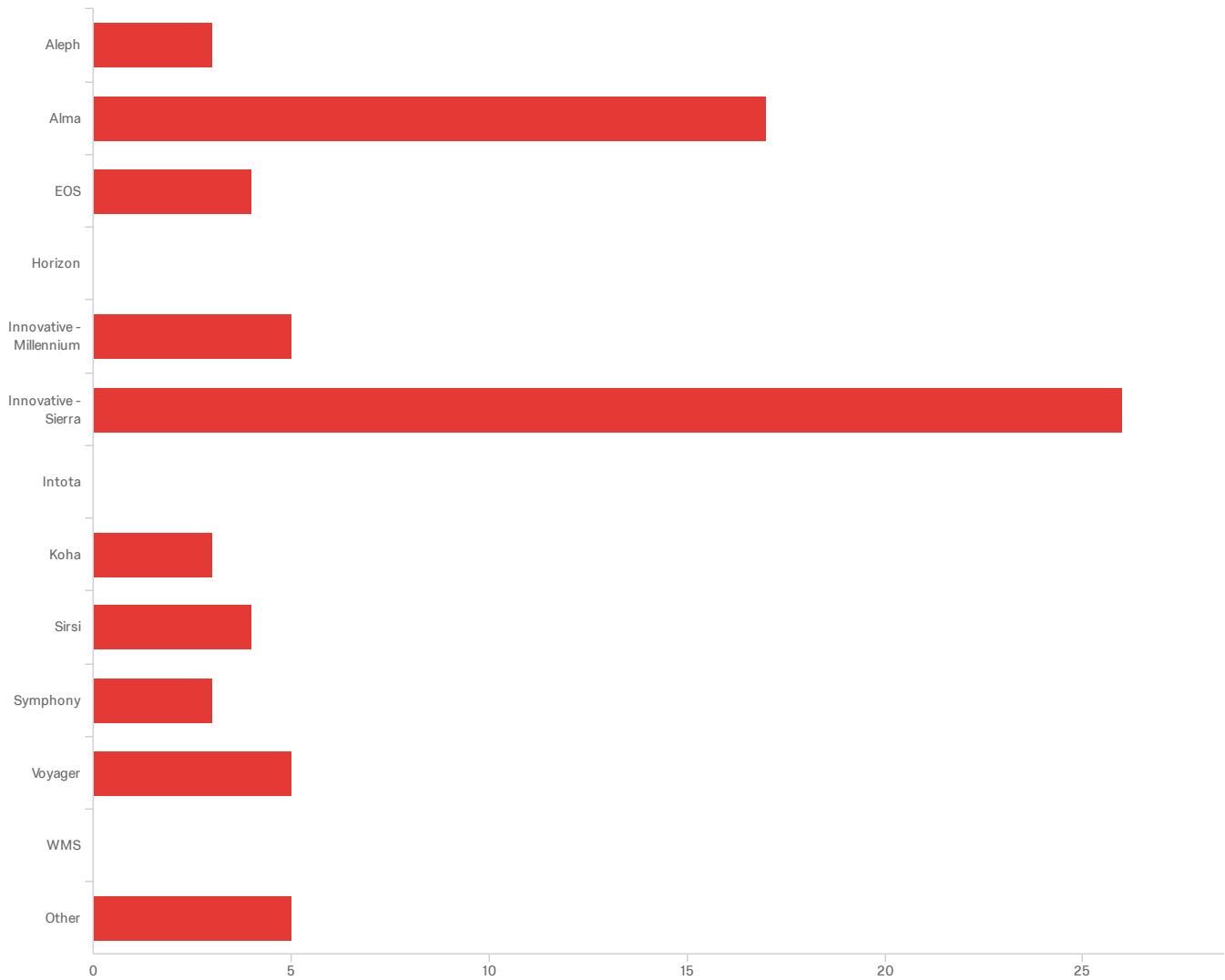

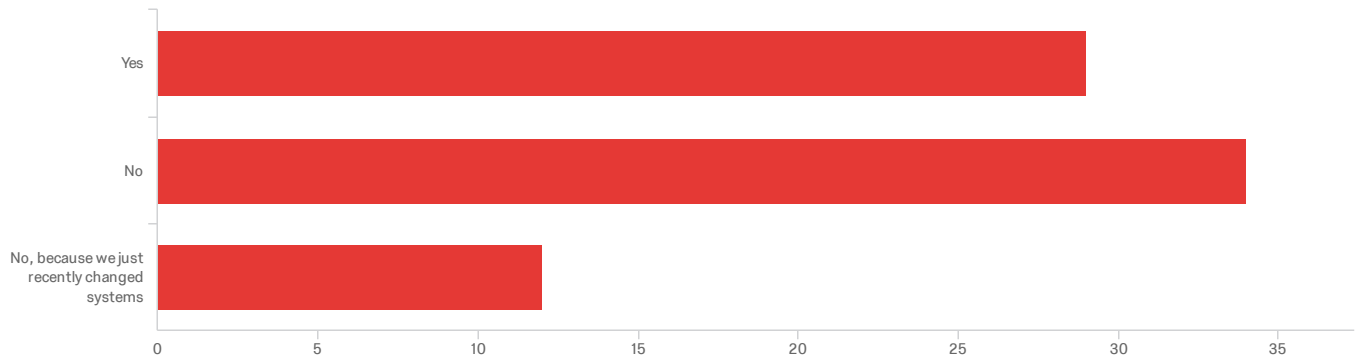

Q14 - Is your library or place of work considering moving to a new library system?

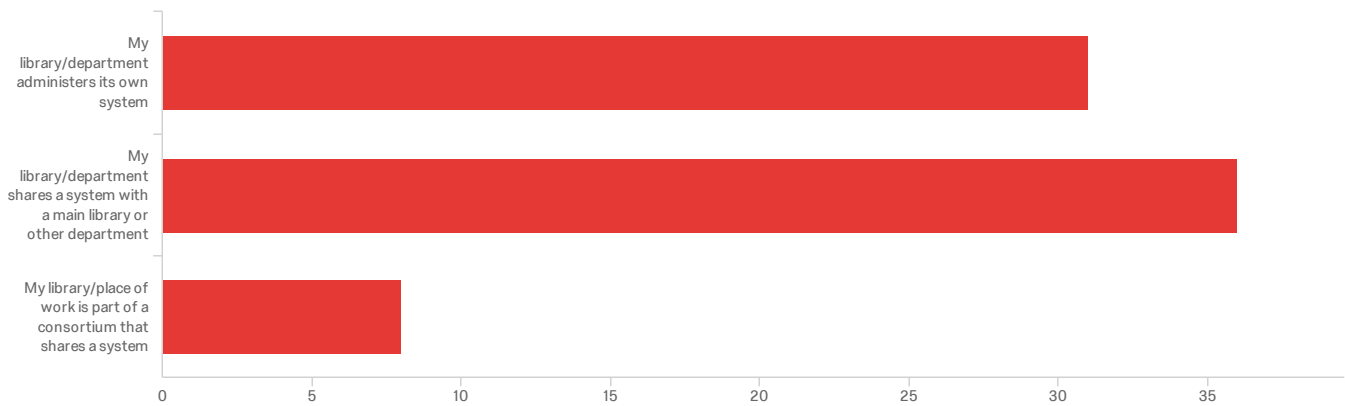

Q15 - How is library system administration structured at your institution or place or work?

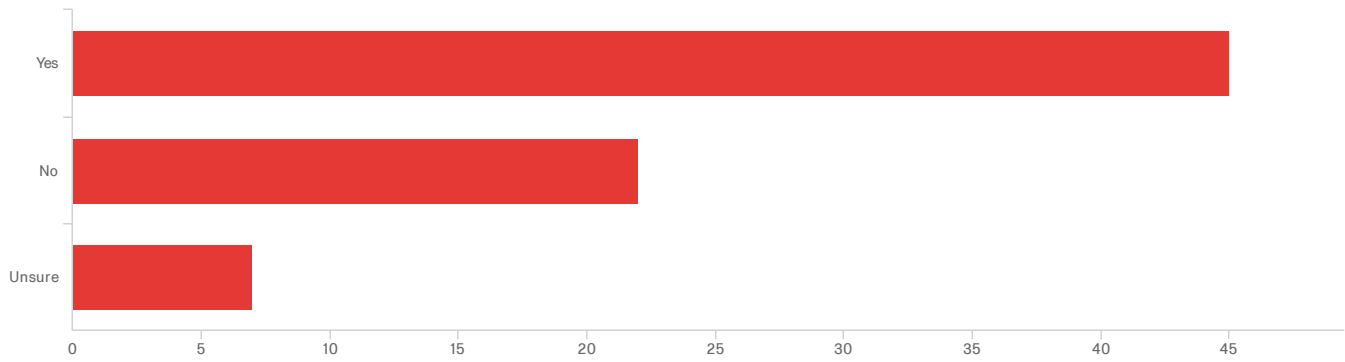

Q16 - Does your library use a discovery system?

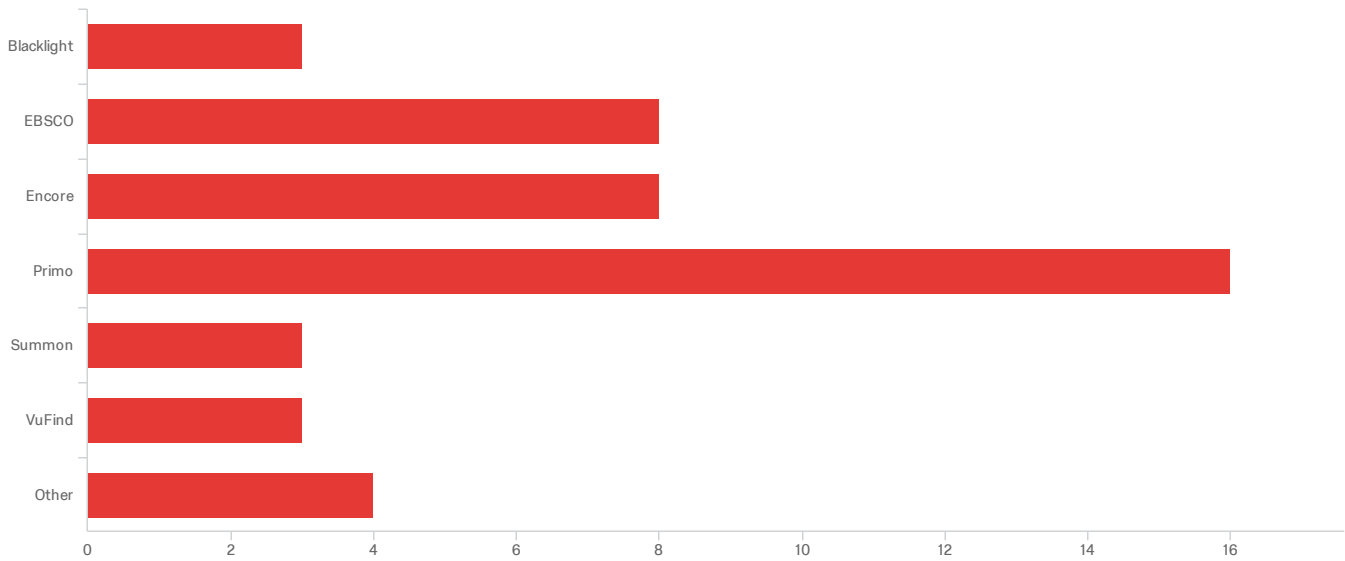

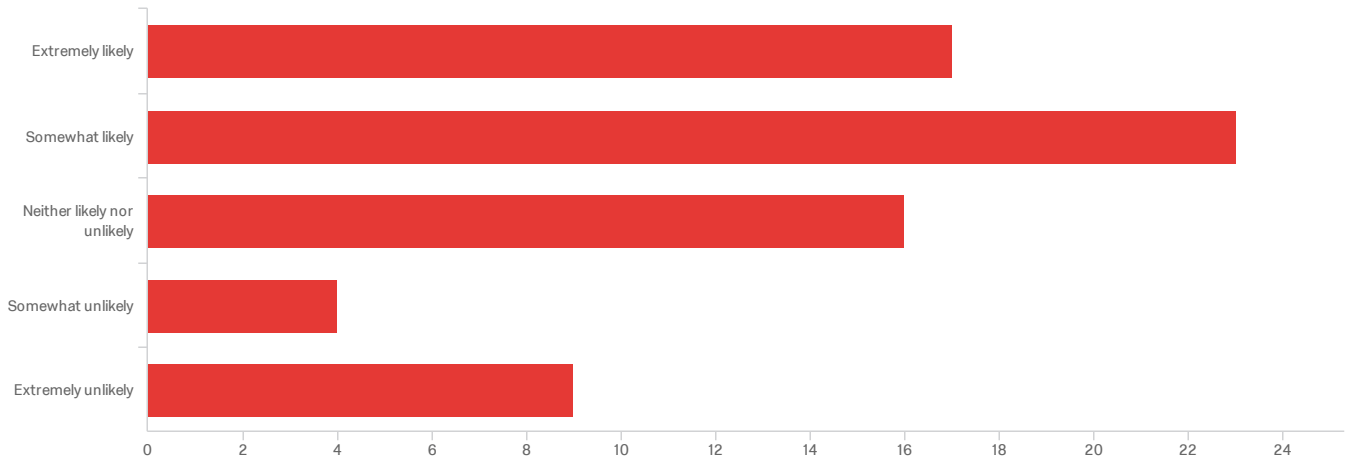
Keep each issue up to 20 pages maximum

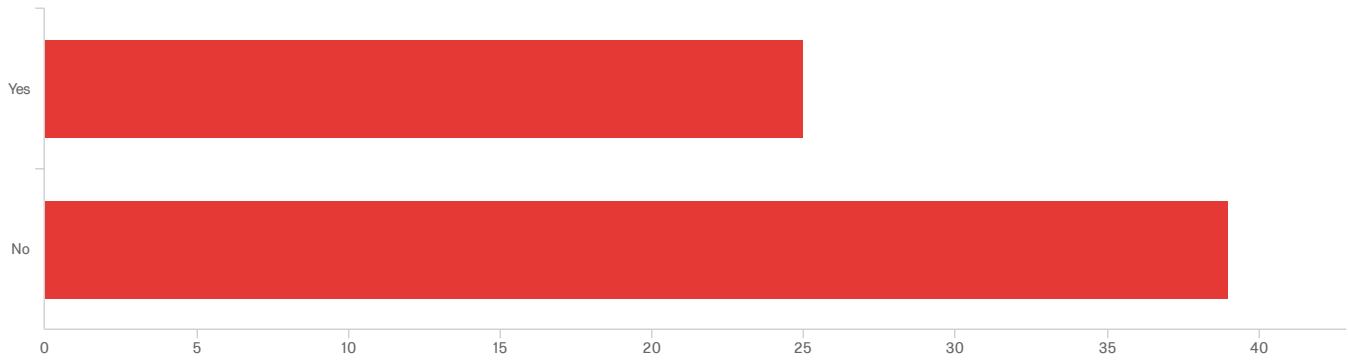

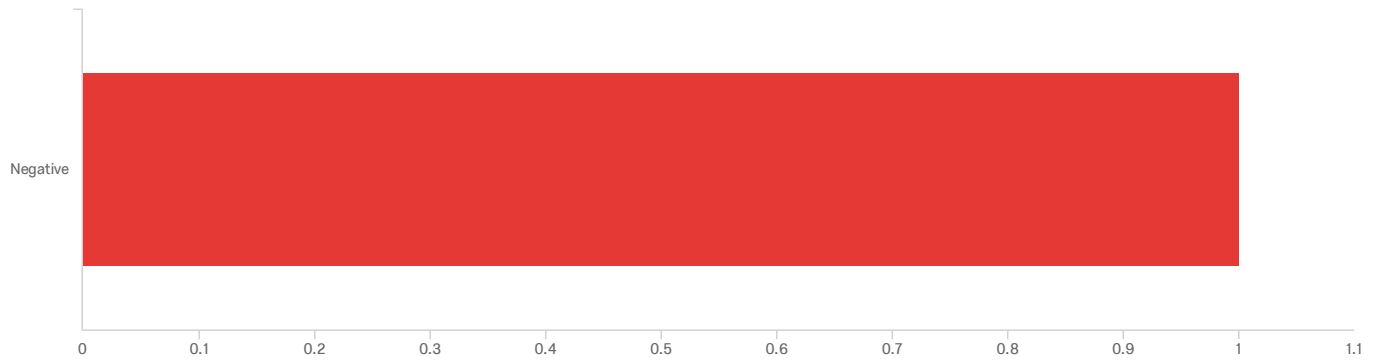

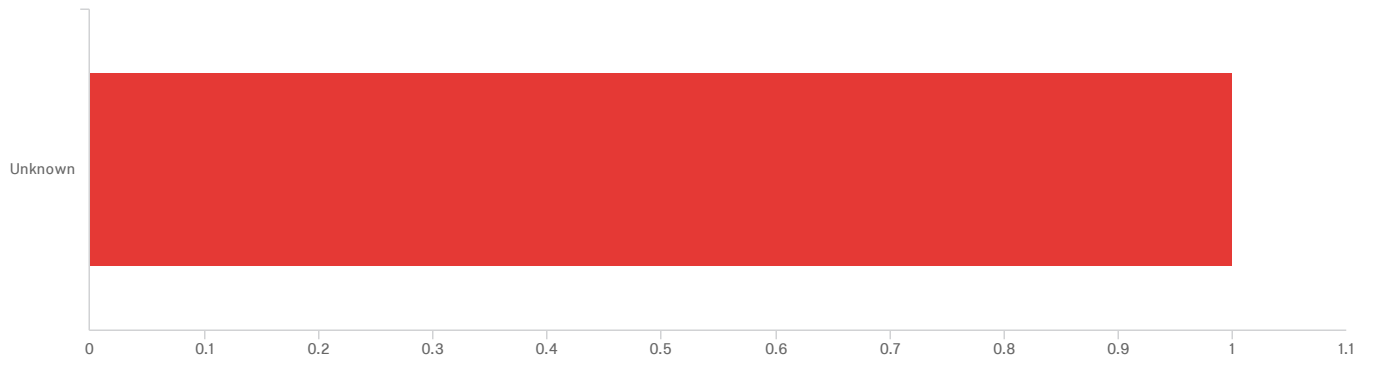
