Boston University:

- Completed our retrospective conversion except for some older English materials in storage until we move into our new building.
- Now working on foreign law reclassification.
- Will begin a project to catalog those materials (primary sources and journals) without cataloging of any kind.

Anne Myers

Cornell University:

- Shared cataloging figures include titles added to existing Cornell University Library records.
- All authority records created are NACO.
- Non-book monographic titles outsourced include some serials. No differentiated count available.

Jean M. Pajerek

George Washington University:

- A reclassification project covering older foreign law materials with non-LC call numbers was completed.
- A major achievement in April 2003 was the loading of the library's bibliographic records into RLIN. Prior to the load, much clean up work was completed, especially for pre-1988 records.
- The cataloging department was restructured this year, so the department now consists solely of professional FTEs, and no longer is responsible for processing materials. One cataloging librarian resigned after six months (to work for LC), but fortunately the temporary part time professional cataloger hired last year for special projects kept the department current in its cataloging. One of the reference librarians contributed cataloging for 45 microfiche records in international law. The increase in the cataloging backlog was limited to storage or rare materials, for which brief records are shown in the local catalog.

Virginia Bryant

Georgetown University:

- *Non-book serial titles* include electronic resources.
- *Authority records created* is from LC's NACO statistics for law project, covering only October 1, 2002-March 31, 2003.

Yuan Yao

Harvard University:

- We sent 3000 titles to OCLC Techpro, but because of import problems that were not resolved until July we didn't start processing these titles until August. They will be included in next year's statistics.

Ann G. Sitkin

Los Angeles County Law Library:

- We have finished our library's authority file conversion for name, series and uniform titles. We have started to outsource our British secondary legal materials to MARCLink. We continue retrospective conversion for other primary legal materials, especially for works microfilmed as part of the Common Law Abroad project of LLMC.

Ming Lu

New York University:

- *Total number of titles cataloged* includes Early English Books Online records.

George Prager

Saint Louis University:

- SLU Law does not track cataloging source by type of material.
- Backlog includes government documents in SuDocs arrangement not yet cataloged.
- Sources of outsourced records:
 - MARCIVE
 - CIS
 - Hein (ABA Archive)

Richard C. Amelung

Univ. of California, Los Angeles

- Recataloging defined: at UCLA Law Library, catalog maintenance (closing records, adding supplement notes, etc.) does NOT constitute recataloging. Recataloging is generally reserved for significant changes, such as changing the bib level from mono to serial, or making extensive revisions to the bibliographic description.
- Source of outsourced records: OCLC Tech Pro for OCLC Gov Docs Service.

Rhonda K. Lawrence

University of Georgia:

- We began a project to smart barcode and RFID security tag our entire collection in April 2002. We have had occasional money to hire temporary employees under the supervision of the Collection Management Librarian, but much of the work has been and is being done by cataloging staff and students. Much of this work is actually recon since there are many materials which were on the shelves, but which could not be barcoded because they had no records in our online system. These are slowly being reconned, and are counted in our stats as recataloging.
- The Cataloging Dept. here is also responsible for:
 1. **Processing ALL materials**; this includes item record creation, label printing, labeling, stamping, marking and RFID tagging.
 2. **All added volumes and copies** (my .5 FTE staff member does only this); this includes retrieving and superseding volumes, all withdrawals and associated item record creation, modification and deleting – as well as updating library has statements.
 3. **All professional librarians work some reference shifts** and participate in team management of the library – including the assistant catalog librarian.
 4. As Head of Cataloging I am the leader of two teams including the library systems team and only catalog about 25% or less of my time.

Elizabeth Geesey Holmes

University of Iowa:

- The cataloging backlog is measured by the number of titles, not linear feet.

Karen L. Nobbs

University of Michigan:

- One librarian (Marylee Dalton) has been “on hiatus” as a cataloger since Feb. 2003, when she became Acting Head of Technical Services in the absence of Suzan Burks.
- Librarians work in all areas of TS, including retrospective conversion. We have no full-time catalogers (professional or paraprofessional).
- To see our total number of recats, add the totals for monograph and serial recats; the figure for “Recataloged Non-book Titles” is a subset of these two. Similarly, The “Retrospective Conversion (non-books)” figure is a subset of the monograph and serial recon total.

Marylee Dalton

University of North Carolina:

- Our cataloging records for government documents are added through the Main Library using MARCIVE.

Terri O. Saye

University of Pennsylvania:

- Total number of titles cataloged includes 56 local (e.g., non-RLIN) bibs, 106 records for monographic gifts outsourced to Marcadia, 1,447 records for microforms (Major studies and issue briefs of the Congressional Research Service), 2,541 microform records (CIS microfiche library), and 2,151 monographic Marcive records (undifferentiated as to format).
- We make no distinction between recataloging and retrospective conversion, and do not report the source of copy used for recon/recat. We also do not report the source of call number for reclassified titles done in-house.
- Extra staffing this year was supplied by 3 part-time support staff members (= 1 FTE), and by a rare book cataloging intern working one day per week.

Judy Vaughan-Sterling

University of Southern California:

- Except for a few stragglers, our JX reclass is complete.

Wendy Nobunaga

University of Texas:

- No distinction made between LC and other shared cataloging.
- No source statistics kept on recataloged titles.

Brian Quigley

University of Washington:

- Recataloged titles: the high numbers in this category may be a reflection of the close scrutiny our collection underwent in preparation for the move to our new building. Also, this was the first year we tracked recataloged titles.

Patricia Hart

Yale University:

- Our recataloging statistics include both recataloging and recon titles.
- These statistics include titles cataloged by the Cataloging Team, Acquisitions FASTCAT staff, Rare Books Department and the Serials Manager.
- We are beginning to outsource and we will keep those statistics in the future. We currently are outsourcing Chinese language materials.
- The special projects staff members are working on materials from our recon and reclass projects.
