Comments

Boston University:

- Will be working on several projects to catalog primary materials, microforms, and electronic resources over the next year.

Anne Myers

Cornell University:

- Shared cataloging figures include titles added to existing Cornell University Library records.
- All authority records created are NACO.

Jean M. Pajerek

George Washington University:

- Outsourced records consist of bibliographic records added to the collection from the OCLC Worldcat microform sets.
- We do not keep statistics by type of copy for recataloged materials.
- The cataloging department is current in its cataloging of recently published materials. The backlog consists of storage or rare materials, for which brief records are shown in the local catalog. Cataloging was able to clear 270 titles from this growing collection.

Virginia Bryant

Indiana University, Bloomington:

- We do not keep cataloging statistics for recataloged items.
- Our Government Documents Department does not break down their statistics for serials/monographs or the LC, shared, and original breakdown.
- This past year we did a major weeding project, hence the drop in our non-microform volumes.

Michael Maben

Los Angeles County Law Library:

- We finally finished the outsourced project for British secondary legal materials (total 7,430 records). We continue our retrospective conversion for other legal materials in house by our staff.

Because of a budget issue, we did some special maintenance projects, such as cancelled copy 2 of state statutory sets OR cancelled the paper version and added the electronic version for other state (not California) materials.

- We also have experienced the migration from RLIN old system to the RLIN 21 new system during 2004/05 fiscal year.

Ming Lu

Ohio State University:

- As of March 2005, the Retrospective Conversion Librarian position (.75) was eliminated due to lack of continuing funding. Conversion and reclassification of older materials is continuing with 1 support staff member dedicated to this task.

Mary M. Rider

Saint Louis University:

- We make no distinction between LC and shared cataloging.
- Saint Louis University will be getting its own ILS during 2006; we will no longer be using a shared ILS with the University of Missouri system. Our vendor will still be Innovative.

Margaret M. Smith

Stanford University:

- Includes 602 Internet titles cataloged with separate records; 38 Internet serial titles. We did not start keeping track of the breakdown between monograph and serial Internet titles until late in the year, so some of the 602 titles may also be serials.
- Our last label run took place in April 2005, and the three year reclassification project is now over. We continue to reclassify the remaining titles in the old classification, but all work is now done in house.

Kathleen Winzer

University of Chicago:

- For the past two years, the D'Angelo Law Library has been barcoding our collection in preparation for high density storage of many volumes. Our cataloger has spent all his time on this project and has not done much cataloging of regular materials, only recon titles. I counted him as the professional FTE for Special Projects – this is not a new professional position. He is not counted as regular cataloging staff.

Patricia Sayre McCoy

University of Georgia:

- Total number of titles cataloged includes 20,961 purchased cataloging records, mainly from Serials Solutions, but also from the e-treatise collection: Eighteenth Century Collections Online from Gale.
- Counts for non-book monographs and serials include all sources other than outsourcing together.
- We sent some of our backlog out to OCLC Techpro to be cataloged, so it is not counted in the linear feet of backlog as of 1/11/2006, but we did not receive any cataloging records for these materials in FY04/05. (Also includes backlog of materials with only brief records in GAVEL).
- Student assistants worked on smart barcoding cleanup project.
- Additional FTE support staff position in cataloging is still frozen, but we did receive one-time funding to hire temporary staff for smart barcode cleanup project. This staff worked from February-June 2005.
- We are still doing barcode cleanup, which involves a lot of recon cleanup and recataloging.
- Cataloging staff also do all processing, added copies and volumes, and superseding items and withdrawing items.
- Our second professional cataloger retired at the end of this fiscal year and her productivity was not high.
- I have many other duties in addition to cataloging – such as leading two teams, participating in overall library management, training, working the reference desk, and serving on the library's public relations and facilities teams. I only catalog about 25% of my FTE work week.
- We use SEPARATE records for electronic and print versions of the same resource.

Elizabeth Geesey Holmes

University of Iowa:

- The cataloging backlog is measured by the number of titles, not linear feet.
- Electronic resources are included in non-book counts.

Karen L. Nobbs

University of Michigan:

- Librarians work in all areas of Technical Services. We have no full-time catalogers (professional or paraprofessional).
- When we have multiple versions of a title, we generally “piggyback” the non-book version (electronic, microform, etc.) onto the print record. When piggybacking onto an existing record, we count these as recats.
- “National authority records created” includes NAF/SAF records added to our local system.

Timothy H. Gatti

University of Minnesota:

- Staffing data includes retrospective classification work.

Mila Rush

University of Pennsylvania:

- Total number of titles cataloged includes 19 local (e.g., non-RLIN) records, 2,132 monographic Marcive records (undifferentiated as to format), 1,800 records in Major studies & issue briefs, and 2,650 records in the CIS microfiche library.
- We make no distinction between recon and recat.
- We do not report source of copy used for recon or recataloging, and do not report the source of call number for reclassified titles.

Judy Vaughan-Sterling

University of Texas:

- No distinction is made between LC and other shared cataloging.
- No source statistics are kept on recataloged titles.
