- The total number of titles cataloged 2006/07 does not include 783 bibliographic records for internet resources cataloged for the collection, and 912 outsourced bibliographic records added to the collection from the OCLC WorldCat electronic collection of LLMC records, so these cataloging statistics reflect those sent to the ABA.
- Non-book titles outsourced records consist of bibliographic records added to the collection from the OCLC WorldCat microform collection sets, CIS, and MOML records.
- Cataloging does not maintain statistics by type of copy for recataloged materials.
- The cataloging dept. is current in its cataloging of recently published materials. The backlog consists of storage or rare materials for which brief records are available in the local catalog. Cataloging was able to clear 432 titles this year from this growing collection. The library added an additional cataloging position to the department to address the increasing number of foreign language print materials in this collection, but the candidate search was unsuccessful.
- Administratively at GW, the cataloging staff consists solely of professional FTE. We did have a student this year assist with a continuing project to add OCLC records to the catalog for titles within the microform Law Books Recommended series for which WorldCat collection sets are not complete. Within technical

services in serials and processing, there are four support FTE and one student FTE who have responsibilities (added vols., binding, linking and labeling, quality control) which might be considered part of cataloging at other law libraries.

Virginia Bryant

**Harvard University:**

- Backlog in linear feet is Monographs only.
- Records appeared in RLIN until summer 2007. No new cataloging was loaded in RLIN since July 2002, when we switched to Ex Libris. All records will be loaded into OCLC beginning March 2008. It will take about 6 months to catch up.
- Currently have two Cataloger vacancies, but they occurred after July 1<sup>st</sup> and are not included here.

Ann Sitkin

**Los Angeles County Law Library:**

- During 2006/07 fiscal year, we finished the RLIN/OCLC merger. We were planning to migrate our ILS to the new system but it did not happen. We continued our retrospective conversion for US and foreign legal materials in house, in addition to the new books' cataloging.

Ming Lu

**Ohio State University**

- I hired a recent M.L.S. graduate to help speed-up completion of retrospective conversion/reclass of older, foreign law materials. This was a temporary (6 mos.) contract position working 20 hrs. per week (.5 professional FTE).
- I also arranged a contract agreement with University Libraries' Cataloging Dept. to have their student(s) trained to assist with completion of copy cataloging/retrospective conversion of older American and English legal materials. Beginning Jan. 07, this project involved 20 hrs. per week (.5 student FTE) with some oversight from a professional librarian. Work on this project is now close to completion.
- Retrospective conversion/reclass of older print materials (acquired prior to 1987) should be completed by end of 2008. The remaining materials (ca. 420 linear ft.) are foreign law materials in English and foreign languages, including a number of large sets.

**Saint Louis University:**

- We make no distinction in our statistics between LC and shared cataloging.

- The outsourced Non-book monographic titles are the Making of Modern Law collection.
- The outsourced Monographic titles are Marcive records.

- We don't keep track of the source of cataloging, the source of classification numbers for reclass, or the number of titles for which we do retrospective conversion or recataloging.

#### **University of Chicago:**

- Statistics for reclassified materials were taken by volume count this year—this was the number of volumes relabeled. The title count is much lower because we concentrated on reclassifying and relabeling serial titles. Due to miscommunication with the student, titles were counted incorrectly and so are not reliable.

#### **UC Berkeley**

- 2007-2008 we're embarking on an ambitious project to reclassify the whole library to LC (from LA County). We've completed KU-KVZ (Australia, New Zealand, Oceania) and are currently working on KQ-KTZ (Africa), which we anticipate finishing by the end of August.
- We've changed our workflow around to prevent backlogs from developing. All material is searched (and cataloged) by any cataloger. Material with no record is then sorted by language. Keeping on top of the incoming material seems to be the key.

#### **University of Georgia:**

- Added 59,196 MOMW records

- Non-book items not tracked by source of records unless outsourced
- Retrospective conversion not tracked separately from recat.
- Authority statistics for local not tracked. Not a NACO library

Suzanne R. Graham

**University of Iowa:**

- The cataloging backlog is measured by the number of titles, not linear feet.
- Electronic resources are included in non-book counts.
- Integrating resources (print) are counted as monographs

Karen L. Nobbs

**University of Michigan:**

- We also loaded 1771 vendor monograph records and 279 vendor serial records in 2006/2007. We do not include these in our cataloging statistics.
- We have no full-time catalogers. Cataloging librarians and paraprofessionals all have additional responsibilities.
- We lost 1.5 FTE positions in April with the retirements of Marylee Dalton (librarian) and Lynn Drickamer (paraprofessional)
- For some categories of materials, we use a single record approach for multiple formats. When we “piggyback” a non-paper version onto a print record, we generally clean up the paper record and count it as a recat.

In the future we will be adding cataloging for electronic resources for CALI, Westlaw treatises, Lexis treatises and World Trials.

**University of Pennsylvania:**

- Total number of titles cataloged includes 21 local (e.g., non-OCLC) records, 2,215 monographic Marcive records (undifferentiated as to format), 903 records in Major studies & issue briefs, 21,811 records from The Making of Modern Law, 2,580 CIS records, 2,940 Lexis/Westlaw records from Cassidy, and 179 new records from Serials Solutions.
- We make no distinction between recon and recat.
- We do not report source of copy used for recon or recataloging, and do not report the source of call number for reclassified titles.
- One support staff position has been vacant since September 2007. A paraprofessional and I have been doing the work; it is likely that this position will eventually be shared with another department.
