- Cataloging statistics reflect in-house and outsourced cataloging only; we do not count vendor bibs (Serial Solutions, etc.) because the numbers fluctuate so. Instead we simply count the number of electronic titles to which we have access. At the end of 2010/2011, we had internet access to 82,845 titles.

Freda Baum

University of Pennsylvania

- Retired Catalog librarian worked part-time July-Dec., cataloging rare books.
- Total number of monographic titles cataloged includes 93 local (e.g. non-OCLC) records and 1,481 vendor records from Marcive. Total number of non-print monographs reported includes 228 local records for faculty papers in SSRN, 1,933 Marcive records, 2,931 Lexis/Westlaw records from Cassidy, 1,314 LLMC records, 14 CALI records, and 7,226 CIS records (these figures may include a small number of continuing resource titles). We also loaded 208 e-journal records from Serials Solutions.
- We make no distinction between recon and recataloged.
- We do not report source of copy used for recon or recataloging, and do not report the source of call number for reclassified titles.
- New HeinOnline records from Cassidy are not reported this year because all cat dates were replaced when Cassidy de-duplicated and redistributed the database late in 2011.

Judy Vaughan-Sterling

University of Washington

- We count all vendor records as continuing resources.
- We do not keep statistics on recataloged on recataloging activity.
- Professional: one .40 FTE; another .50 FTE provided by staff from another unit; Support Staff: one 1.0 FTE who catalogs along with other duties, one .625 FTE, two para-professionals (.40, .50) who catalog along with other duties.
