Comments

Boston University

Given current system restrictions, we were not able to differentiate between monograph and continuing titles for our vendor supplied electronic records in 2013/2014. However, next year we should be able to split our vendor records between these two categories.

Russell Sweet

Cornell University

- We do not differentiate between vendor & outsourced records.
- We do not keep statistics on electronic cataloging backlog.
- Shared cataloging figures include titles added to existing Cornell University Library records.
- All authority records are NACO.

Jean M. Pajerek

George Washington University

- Cataloging does not maintain statistics by type of copy for recataloged materials.
- The cataloging dept. is current in its cataloging of recently published materials. The backlog consists of storage or rare materials for which brief records are available in the local catalog. Cataloging was able to clear 1245 titles this year from this growing collection.
- As of May 1, 2014 technical services lost a full-time position, whose responsibility partially included the cataloging of continuing resources. The position was reallocated to handle electronic resources.

Virginia Bryant

Stanford University

- If no entry, then we do not keep track of statistics, for example LC versus other types of records. We also do not count any recataloged records.
- The total number of nonprint monographic titles includes some serials. These are outsourced records that are added to the catalog by the main library. I receive only the total number of records.
- We don't really have a "backlog"—just half a shelf of foreign language titles waiting for copy.

Ryan Tamares

University of Iowa

- Cataloging backlog is measured by # of titles, not linear feet.
- This year we implemented YBP Gobi³ & SFX, plus transferred 250,000 volumes to our new off-site annex.

Karen Nobbs

University of Michigan

- Our cataloging statistics include in-house and outsourced (Backstage Library Works) only. They do not include vendor bibs (e.g., Serials Solutions).
- 2262 = number of bibliographic records cataloged. However, the following sections reflect that our annual statistics compilation method has changed from previous years. A major change is that a title in multiple formats is counted as a separate title for each format, even if piggy-backed onto one bibliographic record.
- We do not track source of call number for reclassified titles.

Deborah DeGeorge

University of Pennsylvania

- Total number of titles cataloged includes vendor records sourced from Marcive, MOML, LLMCDigital, Cassidy, and Serials Solutions. Outsourced print monographic records are from OCLC's WorldCat Cataloging Partners.
- We make no distinction between recon and recat.
- We do not report source of copy used for recon or recataloging, and do not report the source of call number for reclassified titles.
- Staffing figures for the Metadata Services Dept. are the lowest ever. The German-language cataloger was not replaced when she retired; German-language materials are now being outsourced to Backstage Library Works. This began in the current fiscal year, so those titles are not yet reported.
- The Metadata Services Librarian will begin two years of a voluntary "phased retirement" plan in July 2015, reducing her to 0.6 FTE. No decision has been made about filling her position.

Vendor records: We did not load vendor records for electronic resources in 2013/2014 due to our migration to Ex Libris Alma.
