TS-SIS VICE CHAIR ANNUAL REPORT 2021-2022

As more of our institutions have moved back to a mostly on-site work schedule, we have found it especially challenging to solicit responses from the membership, particularly regarding volunteer needs.

In February 2022, the TS-SIS Biennial Survey was posted to the TS-SIS membership via My Communities. We received a total of 63 responses from the membership. Of these responses, approximately 86% were from academic law librarians, and 52% of responses were from 20+ year employees of law libraries. Nearly 89% of memberships are paid for by member institutions. The budget constraints faced by libraries due to the COVID pandemic are likely to be contributing factors to members' lack of willingness to volunteer. We have all been faced with staff vacancies, leaving us with less time to spend on outside commitments.

During the final three weeks of April 2022, the TS-SIS annual volunteer survey was posted to solicit volunteers for TS-SIS committees and other representative positions. The official survey received 30 responses from TS membership, in addition to two direct email responses received from members. All committee chair/co-chair positions for 2022-2023 were filled through these member responses, as were upcoming vacancies in TS representatives for FROG and the TSLLE Editorial Board.
