AALL Names 2014 Emerging Leader Award Recipient

Chicago 6/6/2014—The American Association of Law Libraries announced today that Janine Liebert, programs and partnerships librarian at the LA Law Library in Los Angeles, California, has been chosen as the 2014 AALL Emerging Leader Award winner.

The Emerging Leader Award recognizes newer AALL members who have already made significant contributions to the association and/or to the law librarian profession and have demonstrated the potential for leadership and continuing service.

Liebert's employer, the LA Law Library, is the second largest public law library in the U.S. and serves the public, self-represented litigants and the legal community.

"I am honored to have been chosen as a 2014 Emerging Leader Award recipient," Liebert said. "I value and am thankful for AALL's advocacy efforts and continued support for law libraries as part of the solution to the justice gap. I hope to continue to develop programs at LA Law Library that further this cause—and to increase my involvement with AALL throughout the rest of my career."

Emerging Leader Award nominees must be in their first 10 years of law library experience. The winner receives a \$500 cash prize.

Liebert will be recognized as an Emerging Leader Award winner at AALL's upcoming 107th Annual Meeting & Conference, which will be held in San Antonio, Texas, from July 12-15, 2014.
