The court has original jurisdiction in all felony proceedings, in civil cases where the amount in controversy exceeds \$10,000, and in equity matters. (The court has concurrent jurisdiction with the District Court in civil matters in which the amount in controversy is between \$5,000 and \$10,000.) Appeals from District Court trials result in trials de novo, entirely new trials, in Superior Court. The court also hears agency, zoning board, and Probate Court appeals, among others.
