### SUBMISSION DEADLINE: OCTOBER 11

Advance the law librarianship profession while positioning yourself as a thought leader by [submitting a program or workshop proposal](#) for the **2023 AALL Annual Meeting & Conference—Map Our Future**—scheduled to be held July 15-18 in Boston.

AALL 2023 programs will feature relevant and timely legal information topics, incorporating the six domains of [AALL's Body of Knowledge \(BoK\)](#). The Annual Meeting Program Committee (AMPC) is comprised of [content area teams](#) that reflect these domains.

#### THINGS TO KNOW FOR 2023

- The deadline for submitting a proposal is **October 11 at 11:59 p.m. (PDT) / 2:59 a.m. (EDT)**.
- As part of AALL's commitment to include new and diverse voices, we encourage proposers to work with speakers who have not previously presented at an AALL Annual Meeting.
- In an effort to have a diverse group of speakers and thought leaders on educational programs, we request that an individual be involved with a maximum of two programs.
- We will remove identifying information from proposals during the proposal review process to focus on the content and takeaways of the proposal.
- Proposers will have the opportunity to share how their program relates to diversity, equity, and inclusion.
- Explore the **"must-have" program topics** that AALL members have identified as being vital to their professional education.
