Papers will be reviewed by the AALL/LexisNexis Call for Papers Committee and all decisions are final. By submitting an entry, applicants grant AALL full rights to publish, reproduce, and publicize entries in any paper or electronic publishing formats.

Papers may be submitted in any of the following categories. Papers and supporting documents for the Open, New Member, or Short Division **must be submitted by March 1, 2026**, and papers and supporting documents for the Student division **must be received by May 15, 2026**.

- Open Division:** for active and retired AALL members and law librarians with five or more years of professional experience.
- New Members Division:** for recent graduates and AALL members who have been in the profession for fewer than five years.
- Short Form Division:** for AALL members; articles in this category will be shorter than a traditional scholarly article and may be appropriate for publication in AALL Spectrum.
- Student Division:** for those enrolled in library school, information management school or the equivalent, or in law school. Entrants in the Student Division need not be members of AALL.
